Warm weather is here and I hope all of you have had a chance to step out and feel it.


So wonderful see classes going and crafters crafting. A big thank you goes out to our moderators and class teachers for helping get our club running once again.

Board Meeting Agenda 03/10/21 – called to order at 7:07 PM

- 1. Welcome to attendees: Holly Smith, Kealy Goodale, Glen Toepfer, Jerri Heer, Steve Stalker, Angela Williams, Todd Goodale, Michelle Grigore, Cathy Clevenz, Joanna Toepfer.
- 2. Secretary Report Minutes from Feb 15 meeting were reviewed. Michelle made a motion to accept, Cathy seconded. Motion carried.
- 3. Show Update Jerri & Joanna
 - a. Facility Discussed best option for facility the Wood County Fairgrounds. Joanna negotiated a five-year contract at a rate of \$7000 per Show, Thursday thru Sunday. Space has 33,000 Sq Ft, free parking. FOP on campus for security. Jerri made a motion to accept this contract, Todd seconded. Motion carried.
 - b. Dates Dates will continue to be first Weekend after Labor Day, this year September 10-12.
 - c. Budget We are still working on the budget.
 - d. MWF Convention Jerri reviewed MWF needs. Host Hotel arranged as well as meeting space.
- 4. Treasurer Glen
 - a. Report Reviewed current financials. Steve made a motion to approve, Michelle seconded. Motion carried.
 - b. Budget
 - i. Reviewed a Moderator's form produced to help track money coming in.
 - ii. Tablet Purchased, programmed and in use at Craft Center.
 - iii. Discussed need for internet to process credit card transactions. Talked about the option of getting a MiFi device cost about \$200. Other option is getting WiFi but that would be an ongoing expense of \$35-50/month. Jerri made a motion to have Holly do further research the MiFi device and move ahead if cost of the package is in the \$200 range, Glen seconded. Motion carried.
 - c. Change for sessions completed by GWT supply of change arranged and kept in the office in the Faceteers room.
- 5. Class Results Joanna reported Fordite classes (3) brought in \$220 and 4 new members. Petosky class brought in \$150 and 3 new members. Classes seem profitable. Need to keep that up.

 - b. Electrical final list from Steve and Michelle. Outlets behind cabinets and exit sign, might need to replace one light.

Mineral collection is being stored in Beaders' cabinets. Needs review for keeping, display, auction. Jerri and Joanna will examine them in May.  - d. Smoking report has been made to Health Department. (we may need to report several times to get resolved)
 - e. Minors using lapidary equipment. Propose we allow it with training and supervision. Not young children but maybe Jr. High & High School. Questioned about if any laws spoke to minors using equipment. Tabled for research.
