

Board Meeting Minutes 11/10/21


Attending: Holly, Jerri, Todd, Angela, Steve, Michelle, Glen

- 1. Welcome 7:01 PM
- 2. Secretary Report Jerri Minutes from August meeting transmitted previously. Motion to accept the minutes by Steve, Michelle seconded. Motion carried.
- 3. Treasurer Glen
- a. Written report presented and reviewed. Motion by Jerri to accept. Second by Angela, motion carried.
- 4. Class Results
- a. Steve discussed the Stained-Glass class. Asked if they could become a group. Suggested that they be housed in Faceters room. All agreed. Discussed having a second class on Dec 11.
- 5. Craft Center
- a. ADA Bathroom now complete.
- b. Drains gemcrafters, main room and saw need drains
- c. Saw leaking, needs to be drained and fixed Sherm may have fixed.
- 6. Status of groups -
- a. Beaders, possibly Kealy
- b. Extreme Beaders, meeting weekly
- c. Faceters, none at this time.
- d. Gem Crafters needs wetting agent for water saws. Thursday work sessions full.
- e. Metal Crafters A lot of people have been thru beginning pendant, more regulars now. Work sessions on Tuesday and Saturdays
- 7. Wi-FI: most monthly wi-fi plans are above \$50 unless you already have a cellular plan. Need to discuss if we want to spend more than \$50 a month on something that would be used very little. Decided that we should be able to handle with phone hotspots and contacting Board members to run Square. No need to pay extra. Table for six months.
- 8. Welcome room tables. Beaders would like a couple more tables. Kealy found some in the garage but they are in rough shape. Steve Stalker said they would be good tables to solder on for the stain glass class. Discussed getting 8 new tables for front room. Steve made a motion, Todd seconded. Motion carried.
- 9.CPR Unit for club house. Angela will research possible grants and other funding options.
- 10. Memberships: Michelle want to discuss what to do with individuals that join in June or July who might quit the club if they have to renew a couple months after they joined. Also some individuals renewed using the old form so renewed at lesser amount.
- a. June/July members: paid for a yearly membership so pro-rate their renewal to cover the remaining months of next year. So if they joined in June there membership would take them through the end of May next year. Their renewal would be to cover July to Dec of 2022 (6 months). An individual membership would be 6 months x \$2.50 = 15 plus tax.
- b. Member renewing using old form need to receive an email explaining the wrong form was used and the amount still owed to get them through to Dec. 31st, 2022.

Discussed, decided that Michelle will contact those people to ask them to pay prorated amount to catch up. We will eliminate the renewal form, and a New/Renewal check box and modify the website link to indicate "Membership Brochure/Application"

- 12. Other items. Discussed developing a cleaning schedule. Suggested requiring class participants to clean up after themselves. Suggested cleaning sessions before/after general meetings. Will bring up as discussion topic at next general meeting.

- 14. Steve would like to start repairing floor, needs to be smoothed before painting. Steve will work on it.
- 15. Need to start looking for new chairs.
