

## William Holland School of Lapidary Arts

Did you know that two of our club members teach classes at the William Holland School of Lapidary Arts? The school, located in Young Harris, Georgia, was founded in 1983 by lapidary enthusiasts who wanted a dedicated school for learning lapidary arts instead of just a smattering of workshops.

The school offers more than 20 different lapidary art skills taught by highly trained instructors. Tuition includes accommodations at the lodge or campground on the campus.


All materials will be provided to complete a sterling silver pendant with a polished gemstone cabochon.
