Happy Spring



Geode Exploration with Toledo Gem and Rockhounds along with Brown County Rockhounds at Monroe lake\Devils Backbone Indiana Weekend of May 13th and 14th.

I have read up on a post from <u>Rock Hounds... - FYRNE LAKE FARMS</u> that talks about some pretty good and large finds from this area. It also looks like a hiking trail or road cuts exist that we can access to the rockhound's sites here.

Here is another area called the same Devil's Backbone and not the area we are visiting <u>Devil's Backbone, Crawfordsville, Indiana (hikingproject.com)</u>.

Another area that has geode's and easiest to access is at Monroe lake in the Hoosier National Forest and we will be visiting this site.

Also investigate Indiana State Museum and history on Geofest they list all the types of geodes that exist in Indiana, should be a fun trip for all!

What our trip is going to look like?

Arrive on Friday in Bloomington, Indiana or meet Saturday Morning for Breakfast at 10am and meet the Brown County rockhound club at Cloverleaf Family Restaurant.

Meet at Monroe Lake by 12:30pm to start first collection point (We will get more details from Brown County Club). Cloverleaf Restaurant South | Facebook

Leave and travel to Tunnelton area for second collection point about 3:30 PM, about 1 hour of travel time, collect till 8pm. We are going down to Postilion Rd to Guthrie Creek. I will call Guthrie Township 812-849-9221 and make sure that we can access and collect.

Meet at Hemlock Bluff Nature Preserve Lower parking or meet for Dinner.

#### Route info:

The route to our sites from Bloomington will have us go down 446 south to 50 east then to Leesville Rd. South, left on W Base line then South on 1250 W this gets you to Hemlock Lower parking and to E County Rd 200 S. We will take a right, then a quick left to S County Rd 1200 W keep straight on this road it will change into W County Rd 490 S then end at Jasper McKeaigg Rd we will left and head south to Fort Ritner Rd. Turn left then take fork off to Grindstone Holler Rd this turns into Postillion and ends at Guthrie Creek and last collection point
