



Introduction to Cloisonné Enameling – Sunday July 2 from 11 am to 3 pm. Enamel is colored glass fused to a metal foundation in a kiln or melted with a torch. Adding wires to create design and isolate enamel colors is called cloisonné enameling. Students will create a small copper pendant or earring set using the studio kiln. All materials provided. What will our trip look like?

Meet at Hemlock Bluff Nature Preserve north side for collection site #2 and to see an earthquake fault line. Last Restroom break point. Travel Time 30 mins (These details supplied by Brown County Rockhound Club, Thanks Rhonda Dunn).

Leave and travel to Tunnelton area and possible collection point #3 about 5:30 PM, about 30 travel time, collect till 8pm. We are going down to Postilion Rd to Guthrie Creek.

Meet back at Hemlock Bluff Nature Preserve North Lower Parking to convene and make sure everyone has a clear direction home or to meet for dinner.

Route info: (Last stop for snacks will be at the intersection of St. Rd. 446 & 50 before we head South.)

The route to our sites from Bloomington will have us go down 446 south to 50 east then to Leesville Rd. South, left on W Base Line, then South on 1250 W. This brings you to Hemlock Lower Parking and to E County Rd 200 S. We will take a right, then a quick left to S County Rd 1200 W. Keep straight on this road. It will change into W County Rd 490 S then end at Jasper Mckeaigg Rd. We will go left and head south to Fort Ritner Rd. Turn left then take fork to Grindstone Holler Rd this turns into Postillion and ends at Guthrie Creek, our last collection point.
