Articles of Incorporation

—OF—

THE TOLEDO GEM AND ROCKHOUND CLUB

(Name of Corporation)

The undersigned, a majority of whom are citizens of the United States, desiring to form a corporation, not for profit, under Sections 1702.01 et seq., Revised Code of Ohio, do hereby certify:

FIRST. The name of said corporation shall be The Toledo Gem and Rockhound Club

SECOND. The place in Ohio where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is

Toledo

Lucas

County.

(City, Village or Township)

THIRD. The purpose or purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

A.-- To promote and stimulate popular interest and education in the study of geology, mineralogy, paleontology, lapidary and other related subjects and through membership in the corporation to sponsor and provide means of co-ordinating the work and efforts of all persons or groups interested therein.

B.-- This corporation shall have a perpetual existence but in the event of a dissolution, after the payment in full of all debts and obligations of the corporation of whatsoever kind and nature, and monies and equipment held in the corporation's name shall be distributed exclusively to scientific and educational institutions. Such institutions shall be decided upon by the Board of Directors.

C.-- There shall be no capital stock issued by this corporation and it shall be operated on a non-profit basis, and no part of its net revenue shall enure to the benefit of any member, director, or individual.

D.-- The private property of members shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatsoever.

FOURTH. The following persons, not less than three, shall serve said corporation as trustees until the first annual meeting or other meeting called to elect trustees.
